AN EFFECTIVE DISASTER PLAN

- has instructions that are easy to remember (acronyms often help).
- can be used in different types of emergencies.

Title: Keep Students SAFE

Introduction: Teachers, follow these three steps in case of a disaster . . .

your lives and your students' lives depend on it!

ACTION 1: Stay in a safe place.

Why it is important: During a disaster, find a safe place. Otherwise, you risk getting injured if you do not find cover or if you go outside.

ACTION 2: Ask for help.

Why it is important: If you or your students are injured, ask for help to get medical care and supplies quickly.

ACTION 3: Follow instructions to **E**vacuate.

Why it is important: If the school building is damaged, listen to instructions so you can assist students to evacuate the building.
