SCHOOL ORGANIZATION AND ADVANCED COURSE OFFERINGS

Carmel High School operates on a two-semester, modified-block system with 50-minute class periods three days per week and 90minute periods two days per week. Freshman, Sophomores, and Juniors are required to take 7 classes per day. All seniors have the option of a reduced 6-period day while those employed part-time or concurrently enrolled may reduce to a 5-period day.
