Seminar Discussion Rules

- 1. One person talks at a time, and everyone else listens. The next comment should connect to the first person's statement and build on it.
- 2. Students may only speak about the book for the entire discussion period. If the instructor hears the students talking about their evening plans or anything unrelated to the book, the student will have to leave the circle and receive a "0" on the assignment.
- 3. The leader of the group should both make sure that everyone gets a chance to speak and make sure the group answers each question fully.
- 4. If the group finishes the questions before the discussion period ends, they can go back to answer questions in more depth or talk about some other aspect of the book, but no topics other than the book are allowed.
